New Business

- Net System
 - Club wants to help purchase new net for school program.
 - Andreana checked all school equipment and determined the need for 2 nets and a setting trainer.
 - Nets are \$775 each and the Setter is \$300.

- Jewelry Policy
 - Jewelry is not allowed on the court. Absolutely no hoop earrings, bracelets or necklaces.
 - Stud earrings in the ear are the only exception.
 - Permanent jewelry must be covered or taped over.
- Hybrid Season
 - Andreana presented a season idea that would include June tournaments in addition to a couple earlier in the spring (likely March).
 - Mention was made of how tired and drained the spring sport athletes are especially if they have morning JO practice and games or practices after school. Point made that we are not improving our volleyball program or looking out for the best interest of the players.
 - June tournaments are at closer locations but often during weekdays. Different age groups may be on different days (ie. Monday – 16s; Tuesday – 14s etc.).
 - Registration for closer tournaments is on one website. Registration is easy and available in November. We could register without full knowledge of teams as there is usually a waiting list. These tournaments tend to be against teams in our division such as Roseau, KCC and BGMR. This would give players the opportunity to see who they would be against in school volleyball season.
 - No decision made at this time but will be addressed at next meeting.
 - Also discussed potential for cutting players rather than having everyone make a team.
